Access to Substance Abuse Services

Policy: West Slope Casa providers will provide access to substance abuse services per the ADAD contract.

Procedure:

- 1. Residential and outpatient programs will prioritize admission to the following populations, in this order:
 - a. Involuntary commitments
 - b. Pregnant women
 - c. Injecting drug users
 - d. Females with dependent children
 - e. Drug dependent persons with HIV,TB
 - f. Aid to the Needy and Disabled
 - g. Families and children referred by child welfare
 - h. Minors referred from school-based treatment
 - i. Juveniles referred by juvenile probation
 - j. Adult criminal justice referrals
 - k. Co-occurring disorders
 - I. Low income DUI
 - m. Persons primarily abusing drugs
 - n. Persons receiving therapeutic opioid replacement
 - o. Chronic detox recipients
 - p. Other women
 - q. Family members of service recipients
- 2. Waiver of fee process:
 - a. WSC providers are not expected to provide services for no fee, however, every attempt must be made to arrange for reasonable payment expectations, whether this be through a monthly payment schedule, quarterly schedule, or simply a reduction in fee based on an approved sliding fee scale.
 - b. Inability to pay shall not be a barrier to service provision.
 - c. Payment arrangements will be made on a case-by-case basis assuring payment to providers and availability of services to the client.
 - d. Clients owing balances at other WSC providers must be paying those services off as agreed to be able to access services at another provider.
- 3. Placement in appropriate level of care:
 - a. All clients will be placed according to ASAM criteria. Any deviations from ASAM recommendations must be documented in the chart.
- 4. Wait list:
 - a. A central wait list will be maintained by Colorado West Recovery Center for all four WSC halfway houses.
 - b. Colorado West Recovery Services will maintain a wait list for the intensive residential program and clients will enter the IRT through the wait list.
 - c. OP wait list data will be obtained from DACODS data.
