Quality Improvement Committee

Policy: Each West Slope CASA provider will designate one individual to sit on the Quality Improvement Committee.

Procedure:

1. The committee will meet every other month for regular meetings, in addition to audits and other duties as assigned.

2. Duties of the committee include but are not limited to:
 - Annual Program Peer Reviews
 - Bi-Annual Site Visits and Procedural Reviews
 - Annual Chart Audits
 - Preparation and presentation of audit results to the larger WSC network
 - Critical incident reporting and assessment
 - Client rights advocacy, grievance, and appeal
 - Development of clinical measures in response to ADAD mandates
 - Management of the West Slope Casa Training Consortium for CAC training
